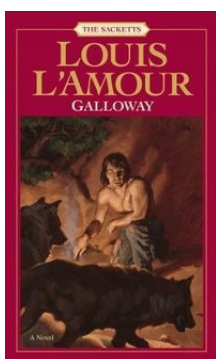


GALLOWAY
