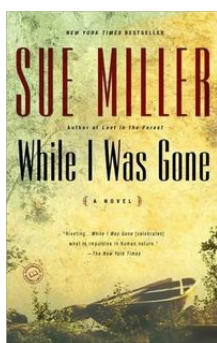


# WHILE I WAS GONE
