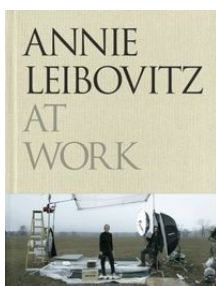


ANNIE LEIBOVITZ AT WORK
